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School Improvement (SI)/Public School Choice (PSC)

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This letter is to inform you that Claymont Jr. High School has been identified as in need of improvement. School improvement means our junior high school did not meet Ohio's goals in science and math for two or more years; as well as average yearly progress (AYP). The students at Claymont Junior High did not meet these goals based on two subgroups: economically disadvantaged and students with disabilities. We did meet the goals for reading and math in 8th grade. The building has been rated **EFFECTIVE** according to the state report card.

Your child can attend a similar school that is **NOT** in need of improvement at no cost to you for transportation. You have the following choice of schools: Indian Valley Junior High School and Conotton Valley Jr/High School. If you are interested in either school, please call us immediately and let us know at 740.922.5478, Ext. 1703. We will provide you with all the needed information to make your school choice successful. The deadline for applying is August 19th.

You may request **FREE** tutoring in place of transferring your child to another school. If you decide to keep your child at Claymont Jr. High, simply have your child report to the school on opening day (August 25th).

Our local report card (<http://www.ode.state.oh.us/reportcard>) and or your child's individual ODE report shows how well Claymont Jr. High did compared to other schools.

To help Claymont Jr. High School get out of school improvement, we have developed plans to ensure that our students do better in all academic areas for the coming school year. You are strongly encouraged to help us make the plan happen.
