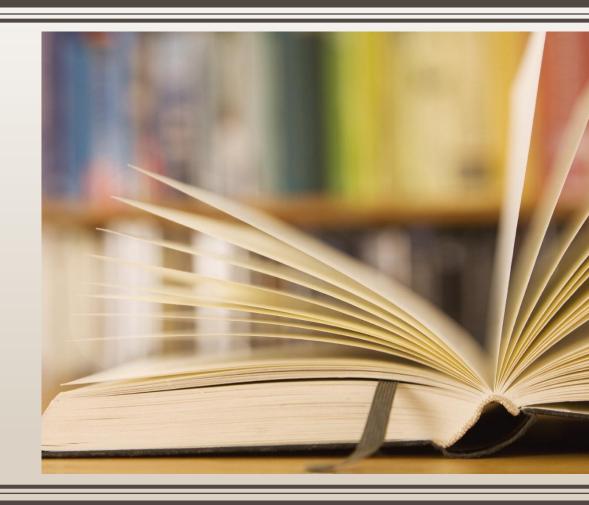

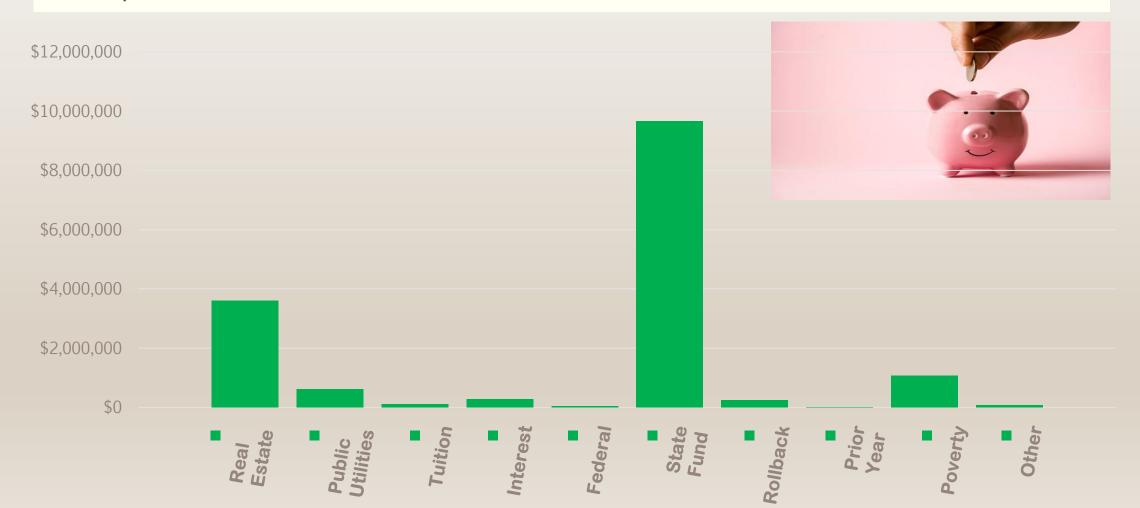

Fiscal Year 2025 (8 months) total revenues are higher than budget: 68.74% (67%)

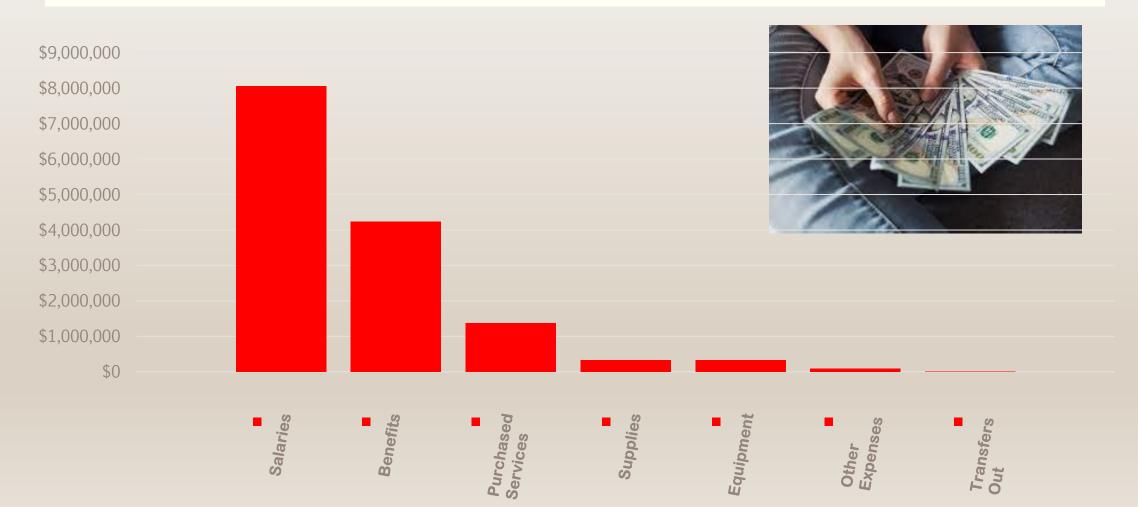
FY25 is up .65% over FY24; FY25 Interest \$279,628.00; Received \$1,825,000 in tax advances



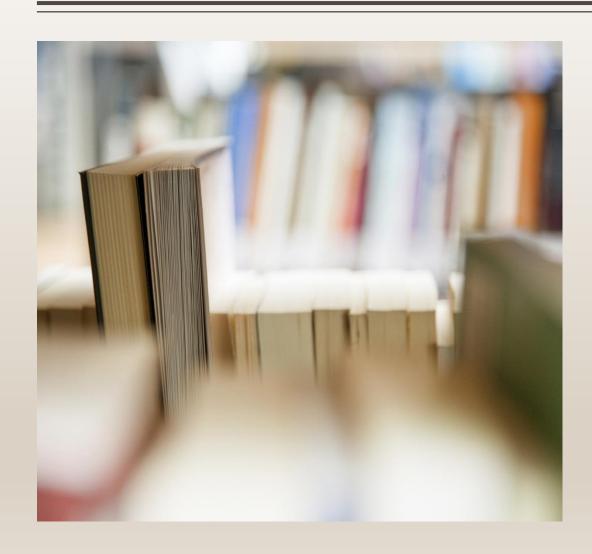
GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES

Gov. DeWine's Budget Proposal (FY26-FY27)

- Initial budget proposal updates the local share calculation, but keeps the state inputs at FY22 levels
- Initial simulations show a decrease in state funding for both years of the biennial budget; current State Share 69.78% (down from 71.34% FY22)
 - FY26 (\$749,845), reduces State Share to 60.5%
 - FY27 (\$780,764), reduces State Share to 56.9%
