23-010 BOARD DISCUSSION ITEMS

Bus Driver Shortage/Absences: Mr. Henry explained that options are being explored due to not

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having enough bus drivers. Two options that are being researched are: expanding the walk zone to a two mile radius and double bussing which would make the High School and Middle School start class earlier, and the elementary schools later. He will be talking to other districts in the county who have double routes.

Intermediate Building Brick Work: Mr. Rentsch stated the Intermediate building needs massive repairs. Every I-beam above the windows on the third floor in the front need replaced before the new roof is installed. Mrs. Lint explained the process and the timeline of the work. Prep work would begin May 8th and the major work would finish before school starts. She also stated the center stairs in front of the building are in bad shape. Talks have happened around taking the steps out completely, except the top set, and plant grass. She will be exploring options when talking to contractors.

High School Concrete: Beth explained the item J on the agenda is for concrete replacement at the High School. This is the walkway, plus additional space for picnic tables by the gym entrance. The concrete is crumbling. The project would start May 30th.

Mrs. Wolf asked Mrs. Lint what changed in the Technology, Computer Network and Internet Responsibility Use Policy on the agenda to approve. Mrs. Lint stated the policy is for 2023-2024 school year, and the charges for damages and discipline language changed from this year's policy.
