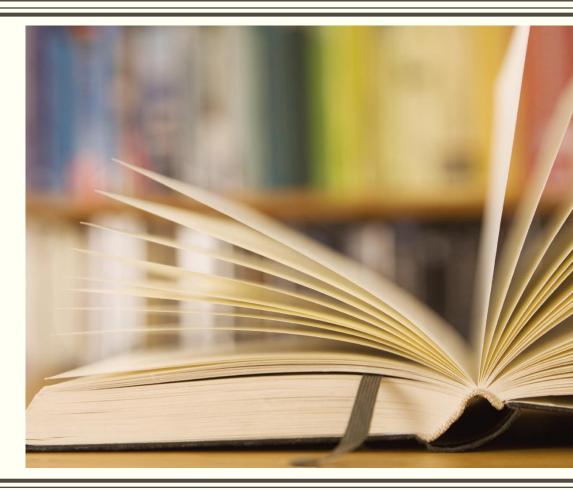

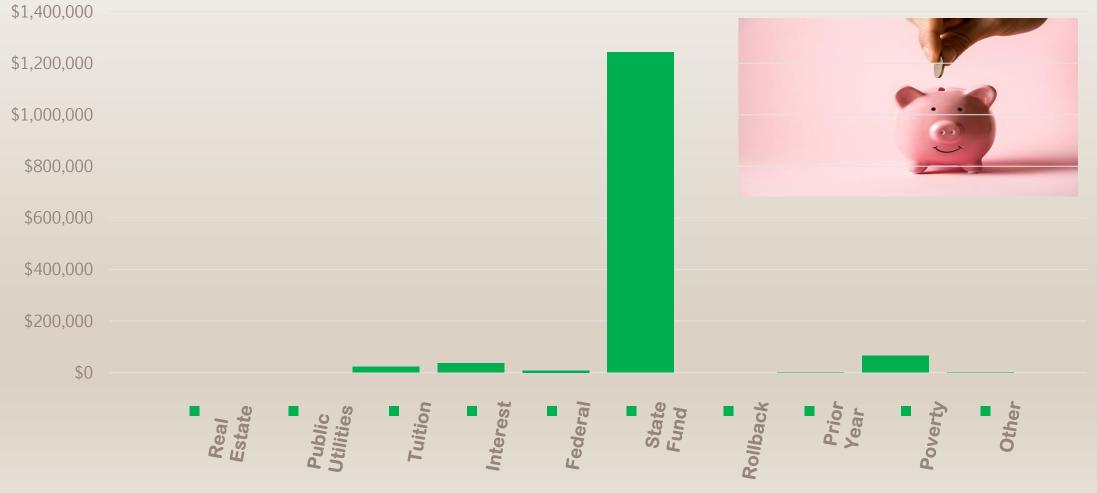

GENERAL FUND REVENUES

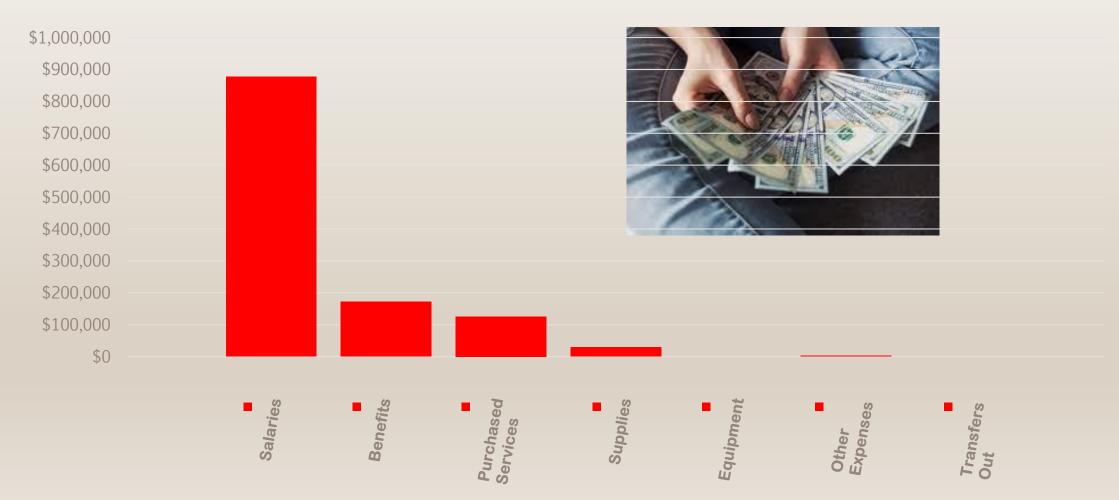
Fiscal Year 2025 (July) total revenues are lower than budgeted: 6.03% (8%)

State hasn't recognized CEP yet, so funding model hasn't changed; 2nd half property taxes will be received in August

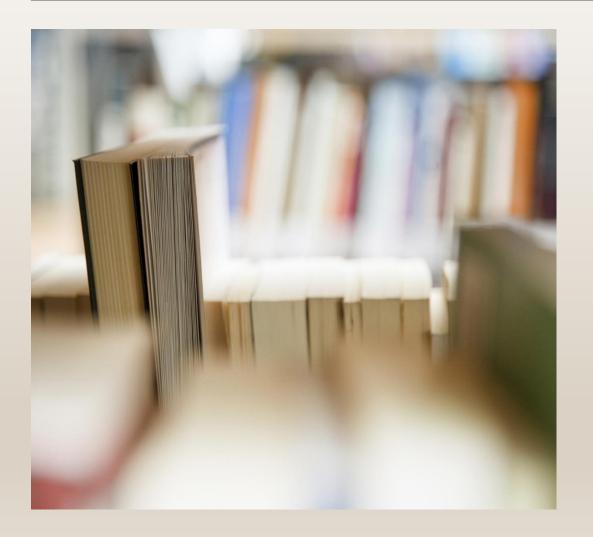


GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES
