## Whole Group Core Instruction

All students receive instruction in the regular classroom setting.

90 Minutes of Core Instruction

### Core Instruction includes:

Phonics, Word Work (Spelling & High Frequency), Reading, Vocabulary,  
Grammar, Comprehension and Writing

Students should be reading texts (decodable, controlled, and uncontrolled) daily



## Small Group Core Instruction

45 Minutes of Instruction

Leveled Readers and Reading Street  
Workstation Activity Centers

Title I and/or Intervention Specialists push into the classroom for Small Group Core Support to assist with Leveled Readers using Guided Reading lessons (Include Independent writing as a center)

- ◇ Teach to mastery (build automaticity and fluency)
