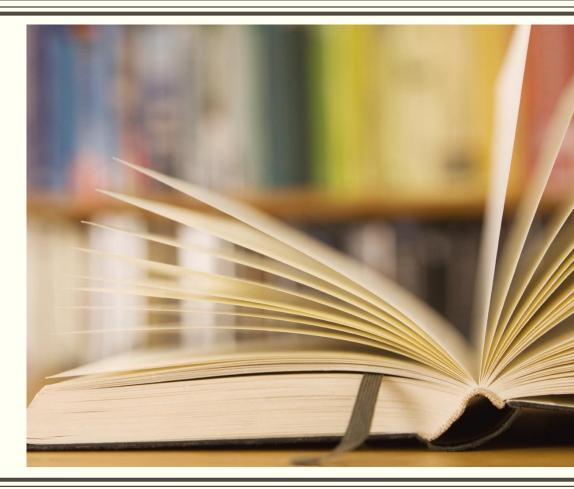

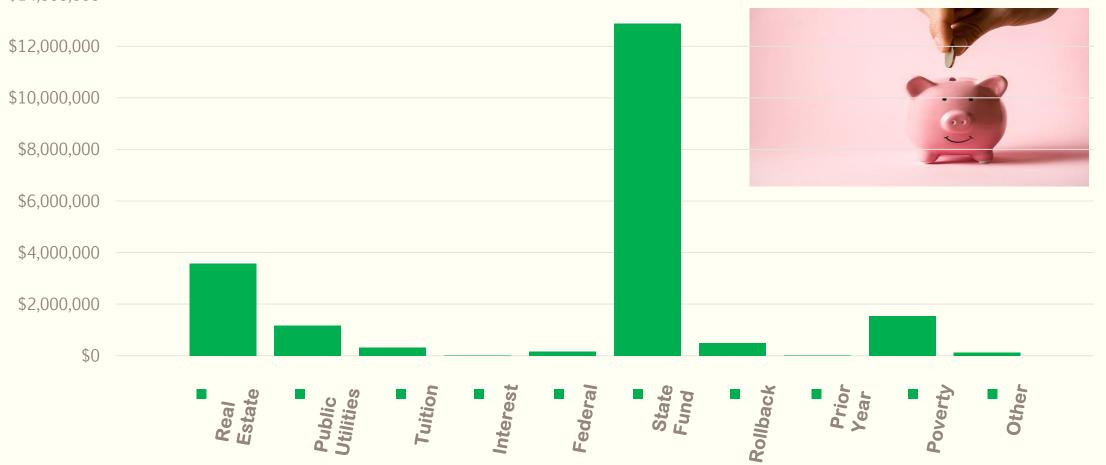

Total revenues are running slightly higher than budgeted: 94.37%

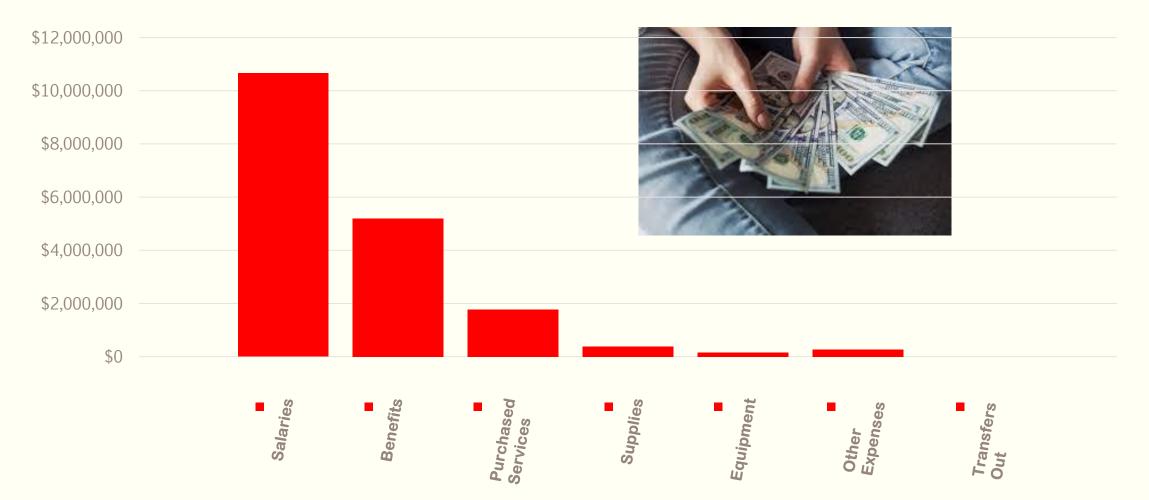
Overall revenues down 4.4% from last year (State funding, BWC refunds)



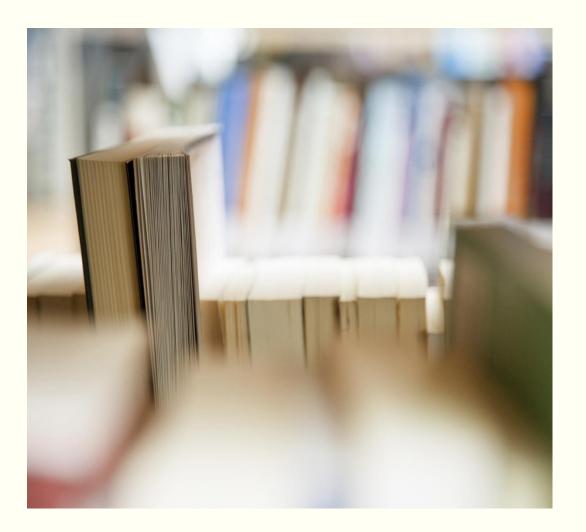
## **GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES**
