Please watch for Positive Office Referrals sent home with your student when they are noticed doing things The Mustang Way. We ask that you sign those referrals and your student can bring them to the office to get a reward. Some of our students' favorite rewards include candy, skip to the front of the lunch line pass, hat day pass, homework pass, books, school supplies, and water bottle stickers. We are also excited to start two new grade-level reward opportunities for responsible use of school-issued technology and good attendance.

Our basic classroom write-up system goes as follows: 1. Documented warning from teacher 2. Phone call home by the teacher 3. A 15-minute detention assigned with the teacher 4. Office Referral

We will kick off the year with our 7 Habits Student Leadership Conference with our students on Friday, 8/25. We encourage all students to be leaders in their own way and that they all have qualities that make them leaders.
