COVID Policies & Protocols

- Practice frequent hand washing. Hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed in high traffic areas throughout the district.
- Social Distancing will be practiced, where possible.
- Staff will be required to wear a mask or face covering.
- Students (grades K-12) are **required** to wear a mask or face covering.
- All students using school transportation **must** wear a mask or face covering while traveling on the bus.



District Learning Options

The District has offered 3 Learning Options for the 2020-2021 school year. Parents can choose the option that best meets the needs of their family.

- A. Face to Face Instruction: The District’s primary learning option will be determined by the risk level based upon the data obtained in the Ohio Public Health Advisory System and impact of COVID within the school system and the community it serves. District families will receive notification from the Superintendent’s office when a change in the instructional format is expected.

- B. Remote-learning: Students will participate in the general curriculum through Google Classroom. A Claymont teacher will assign readings, videos, projects, and activities and will support student learning through assignment feedback and scheduled Zoom meetings.
- C. Fully Online, Self-paced Instruction: Students will be enrolled in an online learning platform to complete lessons at their own pace. Families choosing this option will need to commit to a minimum of one semester on this learning option.
